BLURRING BOUNDARIES IN A HAUSSMANNIAN APARTMENT

The works of art present in this Haussmannian apartment were a true source of inspiration for its renovation. The restructuring of this space is a testament to Atelier DAAA's desire to harmoniously merge the past and the present.

To this end, they decided to keep some of the original elements, such as the magnificent wooden ceiling in the dining room, the cornices and the original parquet floor. These features bring a touch of authenticity to the renovated space.

Working closely with talented artisans, Atelier DAAA also dared to make some bold stylistic moves. For example, bas-reliefs were added to enhance the walls, as well as stained glass windows with geometric patterns that create a fascinating play of light.

The project was designed with a timeless vision, avoiding both excessive ostentation and uncluttered simplicity. The designers used a neutral monochrome with subtle shades of green to create an atmosphere of depth, serenity and density.

This sober space exudes a real serenity, both intense and reassuring. It blurs the boundaries between yesterday and tomorrow, offering a timeless and captivating experience.
